Suggestions For Keeping Up With Academic Demands

Hello Holy Trinity Parents,

As we begin the month of February, we recognize that the academic demands on our students are increasing. While keeping up with homework, tests and quizzes are essential to their learning journey, they can also bring stress and uncertainty to both students and families.

Consider the following in helping your student to not lose motivation and to stay the course. One of our greatest priorities as a faculty is ensuring that each of our students receives the support they need to succeed academically. A significant part of that journey lies in their homework, tests and projects - tasks that are designed not only to reinforce what they're learning but also to help them develop critical thinking, time management and problem solving skills.

We recognize that students often face challenges in balancing school work with extracurricular activities, family commitments and personal interests. At Holy Trinity, we aim to make those assignments meaningful and aligned with what they're learning in class. However, in order for these efforts to truly pay off, it's essential that we all work together to support them - students, teachers and parents alike.

Here are just a few ways you can help foster a positive environment for your child's academic success:

• Encourage Time Management - Set aside regular time for homework, study and project completion. Help your child create a schedule that allows for breaks and enough time to tackle each assignment without rushing.

- Provide a Quiet, Focused Space- Create a dedicated study area where distractions are minimized. This space should be well-lit and equipped with necessary materials (paper, pens, iPad/charger, etc.)
- Check myHTCS regularly Check myHTCS to check for homework, tests and upcoming projects. Remind students of the importance of messaging teachers when they have questions about missing assignments, absences, etc.
- Stay Informed Sign up and attend your child's Winter Conference. This conference serves as a great opportunity to have an open discussion with your child's teacher about their progress and strategies you can employ to ensure they have a strong finish to the school year. Be sure to check your email for the sign up link that was sent out on Monday, January 27th.
