A Message from Rachael Egger Youth Minister

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"White Smoke! We have a Pope!"

Witnessing our teachers and staff model sincere joy and enthusiasm for the Conclave and the announcement of our new Pope was a memory that I will cherish forever. I am so grateful that my kids were able to experience this event with their school community.

If you turned on the footage of the Vatican in a non-Catholic school, without context students might think

they were watching a "seagull cam". And then they would have been confused when the camera switched to a balcony of old men. But at Holy Trinity, the teachers and staff were so excited, and they made sure the students were aware of how significant this process was. Only in a Catholic School could classrooms full of students sit in waiting and anticipation while staring at a chimney. There were audible celebrations echoing in the halls when the chimney was finally active. "White Smoke!" This was followed by an overwhelming sense of joy when Pope Leo XIV was announced as our first Holy Father born in the US! Students were jumping up and down, cheering, and embracing one another. This can only happen in an environment when the adults are freely sharing their joy and excitement...their joy and excitement for our Church.

The joy was contagious at Holy Trinity that day. Our children were genuinely excited about what they were witnessing. They were excited about Our Faith because the adults around them were excited. This was a great reminder that, as a parent, my attitude about my faith directly impacts the developing faith of my children. They may not always match my enthusiasm around going to weekend mass, but I know that one of my greatest responsibilities as their mother is to guide them on their spiritual journey. They don't have to be enthusiastic, yet. In the future when they tell me that mass is boring, I'm going to remind myself that these are the same kids who patiently stared at a chimney, just waiting to see smoke because the adults around them were excited about it. And I'll take a lesson from our teachers and find ways to share my joy around Our Faith.

I encourage you to find ways that you can model your joy for Our Faith with your children this summer. Weekend mass is a great way to stay connected to our community while growing the faith of your family. It's always a treat for our young parishioners to see their friends at Mass! Enjoy your summer, and I'll see you at church!
